

We have moved **Indoors** for our in-person service with an **Outdoor Lobby!**

We will still be socially distancing by sitting in family/group units. Masks will be required for ages 11 and up unless you have a medical exemption.

Kids ministry has started! Please see below for Children's Ministry information.

- Traditions congregation will continue to meet at 8:30 am on Sunday's mornings. They will use the South Office Door.
- CC Spanish will continue to meet at 1:00 pm on Sundays afternoons.

We will continue to have our worship service available online, so there is no pressure to return just now. If you feel more comfortable watching from home, that is great, and we would love to connect with you in that way.

Important Guidelines and Details for indoors in-person services

- 300 person limit for sanctuary per service.
- If you or someone in your family has been sick please stay home.
- No food or drink allowed in the building.
- **Saturday night – New Time - 4:00 pm start.**
- Sunday morning 9:00 am & 11:00 am.
- Seating opens 30 minutes before service start.
- Family / households/ groups stay together. Spacing between groups or individuals.
- We cannot have individuals moving around, congregating in the lobby. This will be encouraged to happen outside.
- People/Groups will be seated by a section host.
- Rows will be dismissed by section hosts after the service is over.
- Masks required for everyone (ages 11 and up) indoors unless on stage or for a medical exemption.
 - People will be asked to put on masks before entering building.
 - Masks will be provided for anyone who does not have one.
 - Anyone refusing to wear a mask will be asked not to enter the building.
 - We will require everyone to wear a mask the entire time while indoors.
- To help with flow, everyone will enter the building through the east main lobby doors.
- Outdoor Lobby will be open before and after services for everyone to enjoy community.

Kids Ministry Information

Children's Ministries will begin **indoors** on **Sunday, September 20.**

Children's Ministries will only be available on Sunday mornings through September.

Saturday 4:00 services will still be Family services. We will have activity packets available for children.

If you are not comfortable coming to an in-person service, we will still be doing Tiny Tots and CCKids services online. We will also have online packets available for you to pick up in the front office during regular office hours. If you have not used an online packet yet, these contain all the items you need to help your child engage with the videos each week.

Important Guidelines and Details for Kids Indoor, In-person Services

- Tiny Tots, CCKids and Loop in-person begins Sunday, Sept 20, 9:00 am and 11:00 am
- Room capacities are significantly smaller than pre-covid. All capacities will be based on room square-footage and volunteer ratios.
 - There is not a reservation system. Any families wishing to utilize Tiny Tots, CCKids and Loop ministries will be able to check their child into these ministries as long as the room capacity has not been reached.
 - If the Children's Ministry areas reach capacity, kids will be given the opportunity to attend the service with their family. Activity packets will be available for kids.
- All room leaders and volunteers will be wearing masks for the entire service.
 - Only kids 11 and up will be asked to wear a mask in the building.
- All volunteers will be washing their hands upon entering the room.
 - Tiny Tots will wash their hands upon entering the room.
 - CCKids and Loop ages will be asked to wash their hands in one of the lobby restrooms before entering the Playhouse.
 - Hand sanitizer will be available for use with adult supervision.
- We will be sanitizing the children's areas before each service. Our rooms will open approximately 15 minutes before the service starts.
- **Check-in will be assisted by a ministry volunteer.**
 - Temperatures will be taken and a symptom check will be reviewed before your child will be checked-in.
 - Tiny Tots parents will check-in their child in the lobby area. Then a Tiny Tots Leader will walk the child to their classroom.
 - CCKids and Loop will be checked-in by the fireplace in the lobby. Parents can let their children walk up the stairs to the Playhouse unaccompanied or parents can accompany their child to the Playhouse entrance using the stairs behind the fireplace. Parents will be asked to stay in the Playhouse lobby and then exit onto the Mezzanine.
- **Picking up your children.**
 - To ease congestion, we are asking that only 1 parent come to pick up their Tiny Tots kids in the Tiny Tots lobby; no parents will be walking down the Tiny Tots hallway. Your child will be lined up and ready for you.
 - CCKids and Loop will be outside the building in front of the Playhouse. A fence will surround the area and no parents will be allowed inside the fence. Children will be brought to the gate for parent pick-up.
