Group Interaction & Application

Read aloud together Matthew 16:13-20.

Take a moment to share some thoughts on the purpose of the church.

For as long as you have been a follower of Christ and part of his church, what are some of the ways you have seen the church work in powerful ways?

As you listened to some of the stories shared about the work taking place at Christ Community this past year, which stories made the greatest impact on you and why?

In what ways has being part of the Christ Community family impacted you personally this past year?

Pastor Alan shared these stories through the lens of what he hopes is the heartbeat of Christ Community – “All things with Christ. As a thriving family. Bringing hope to all people.”

Regarding “All things with Christ,” in what ways are you currently nurturing this reality in your own faith walk?

If you long to experience greater intimacy with Christ, what could that look like?

Regarding “As a thriving family,” in what ways are you contributing to the family of CCC?

If you long to be a more active participant in this family, what could that look like?

In what ways are you receiving the blessing of being part of this family?

Regarding “Bringing hope to all people,” in what ways are you currently sharing God’s hope with those around you?

Who are some people in your current circle you could bless with a message of hope?

What outreach opportunities or strategies excite you?

What other CCC stories have you experienced or heard about this past year that were not shared in this past weekend’s service?

In the spirit of Thanksgiving, if your group still has time, maybe take a few minutes to share some of the things you are grateful for in your current life.

Conclude by praying for one another in taking practical next steps in applying this weekend’s message and group discussion, after which pray for group needs and concerns.
