Anchored Hearts

(I Corinthians 15:55-58)

Group Interaction & Application

Read aloud together I Corinthians 15:55-58.

What words, phrases, concepts, or images from these verses stand out to you as you just read them, or create a curiosity for you in some way?

What aspects of KJ's message gave you fresh insight into this passage, or helped you the most in understanding these verses and what we experience here?

How would you describe what it means for you to be anchored in the heart of God?

How anchored to God's heart do you currently feel?

What does it look like when you feel anchored to God?

What helps you remain anchored to God?

How fully are you living in the reality that death has lost its victory and its sting? (vs. 55)

If you do not feel like you are experiencing this victory to its fullest extent, what might be getting in the way?

In light of this victory over death, Paul declares, "Thanks be to God! (vs. 57)

What does it look life for you when you are expressing a gracious heart towards God?

If you long to experience more gratitude, what steps could you take?

Paul and Hosea both had to share hard things with the audiences they were speaking to and yet they were empowered to say these things because of their rootedness in God.

When have you had to share hard things or taken a difficult stand with those around you – and how did your rootedness or lack or rootedness impact your delivery?

Or where have you held back even when you felt a strong urge to speak up and why so?

If you are wrestling with taking a difficult stand today, what is it you are wrestling with and what could it look like to stand firm – rooted in the love and grace of God?

In the video story shared during service, we experienced a powerful example of God's ability to transform a person's life that becomes rooted in Him.

Where have you potentially seen another person (or maybe yourself) impacted so powerfully when a heart previously unanchored became anchored in God?

Conclude by praying for one another in taking practical next steps in applying this weekend's message and group discussion, after which pray for group needs and concerns.
