The God Who Fights for Us

(Psalm 18)

Group Interaction & Application

Read aloud together Psalm 18.

What words, phrases, concepts, or images from these verses stand out to you as you just read them, or create a curiosity for you in some way?

What aspects of Pastor KJ's message gave you fresh insight into this passage, or helped you the most in understanding these verses and what we experience here?

When have you experienced God's deliverance from a significant trial?

What did it look like to praise God in light of this deliverance?

In what ways does God serve as your foundation?

How appropriate do the words David uses to describe God (rock, fortress, deliver) feel to you? (Psalm 18:1-3)

When have you experienced God's protection in your life?

How protected by God do you currently feel?

When if ever have you cried out to God? (vs. 4-6)

Whether you felt like He heard you or not, share your experience.

When have you been surprised to find out God did hear you when you thought He did not?

What transpired to expose He was listening?

When have you felt God's palpable presence during struggle? (vs. 16-19)

If you long to feel His presence in more tangible ways, share what you long for this to look and feel like.

What level of confidence do you have that God is out in front of you – preparing the path for you? (vs. 28-36)

If your confidence is not as high as you would like, what might it look like to trust God more fully?

Is there a specific area of your life today where you want to place a greater trust in God?

How fully are you able to trust that God is fighting for you? (vs. 47-50)

Where have you seen God fighting for you in the past?

Where do you long to see Him fighting for you today?

Conclude by praying for one another in taking practical next steps in applying this weekend's message and group discussion, after which pray for group needs and concerns.
