Taking it to the Streets

(Acts 3)

Group Interaction & Application

Read aloud Acts 3.

What words, phrases, concepts, or images from these verses stand out to you as you just read them, or create curiosity for you in some way?

What aspects of Pastor Alan's message gave you fresh insight into this passage, or helped you the most in understanding these verses and what we experience here?

Within this portion of scripture, Pastor Alan highlights three things we (the church) can do to spread God's Kingdom.

First, we can see people. Acts 3:4

Share examples of times when you have felt truly seen.

What impact did these moments have on you?

How well do you see the people around you?

When have you seen someone well and what was the result of this encounter?

What could it look like for you to “see” people more fully and more often?

Second, we can bless people. Acts 3:6-8

Share some examples of when you have been blessed by others.

Share some examples of when you have been able to bless others.

What are some of the ways you are equipped to bless those around you?

Pastor Alan pointed out the difference between “declarative prayer” and “prayer where you ask God for something.”

How would you describe the difference between these two types of prayer?

How comfortable are you with both types of prayer?

When have you either been part of delivering a powerful prayer of declaration or been on the receiving end of someone offering a prayer of declaration over you?

How fully are you walking in the authority God has given you?

Third, we can look for ways to connect the good news of Jesus to the stories of those around us. Acts 3:9-12

Who do you know who is carrying the pain of either their past or present life who needs to hear the good news of Jesus’ healing power? Acts 3:19

What could it look like to share this good news with them?

Who do you know who needs to hear the good news of Jesus’ promise for the future? Acts 3:20-21, Revelations 21:5

What could it look like to share this good news with them?

Conclude by praying for one another in taking practical next steps in applying this weekend’s message and group discussion, after which pray for group needs and concerns.
