## Uncomplicated Evangelism

(Acts 8:26-40)

## Group Interaction & Application

Read aloud Acts 8:26-40.

What words, phrases, concepts, or images from these verses stand out to you as you just read them, or create curiosity for you in some way?

What aspects of Pastor Alan's message gave you fresh insight into this passage, or helped you the most in understanding these verses and what we experience here?

Take some time to share with your group how you have engaged with the call to spread God's message of hope to the world around you.

Whether this call has been intimidating or inspiring, share a little bit about your journey with evangelism up to this point.

Within this portion of scripture, Pastor Alan shares four action points he sees in the life of Philip that we can use to uncomplicate evangelism.

First action point, **availability**. (Acts 8:26)

In what ways have you made yourself available to God's promptings?

How available to God's work are you making yourself today?

What might be getting in the way of being more available to God?

Second action point, **proximity**. (Acts 8:29)

Who are you currently in consistent relationship with who do not know Jesus?

Who, if anyone, are you potentially being called into a closer relationship with?

What do you enjoy doing that you could use as a platform to build new relationships?

Third action point, **curiosity**. (Acts 8:30)

How curious are you to find out about other people?

If you struggle to be curious – and maybe tend to turn conversations toward yourself, what steps could you take to change this tendency?

When has curiosity nurtured a relationship in your life?

Fourth action point, **discovery**. (Acts 8:30)

When have you created a space that has nurtured someone wanting to discover more about God with you?

If you know someone who has been hurt by the church, but who has given you signs that they are still interested in Jesus/the Gospel, what might it look like to help them discover a fresh glimpse of Jesus?

Conclude by praying for one another in taking practical next steps in applying this weekend's message and group discussion, after which pray for group needs and concerns.
