Shaped by Grace

(Acts 9:19-31)

Group Interaction & Application

Read aloud Acts 9:19-31.

What words, phrases, concepts, or images from these verses stand out to you as you just read them, or create curiosity for you in some way?

What aspects of Pastor Nate's message gave you fresh insight into this passage, or helped you the most in understanding these verses and what we experience here?

When, if ever, have you made a momentous change in your life that led to a significantly better version of yourself?

What led to this change?

How did those around you respond to this change?

When has someone around you experienced a significant change for the better?

How did you respond to this change?

If you were hesitant to believe the change was real, how did you navigate this tension?

If you were slow to embrace this person's change, how did it impact them?

In Saul's journey of change, grace propelled him forward. (Acts 9:22)

When has God's grace propelled you forward?

Or if you currently feel an urge to move forward but are hesitating, how might grace assist in helping you take a first step?

God's grace empowered Saul to live courageously. (Acts 9:23-25)

When has God's grace equipped you to live courageously?

Or if fear is currently serving as a barrier for you, how might grace help you move past this fear?

While the Christ followers around Saul initially doubted his change, they eventually supported and joined with him. (Acts 9:25, 30)

Who is walking alongside you supporting you in your journey of becoming the person grace has equipped you to become?

Who, if anyone, is holding you back?

In Barnabas (vs. 27), we see an individual who championed Saul.

Who has been a Barnabas in your life?

Who could you serve as a Barnabas for today?

Conclude by praying for one another in taking practical next steps in applying this weekend's message and group discussion, after which pray for group needs and concerns.
