## **Group Interaction & Application**

Read aloud Matthew 18:2-4

What words, phrases, concepts, or images from these verses stand out to you as you just read them, or create curiosity for you in some way?

What aspects of Pastor Stetson's message gave you fresh insight into this passage, or helped you the most in understanding these verses and what we experience here?

When have you been taught something by observing a child?

When have you been inspired by a child?

Read together Luke 10:21.

How do you respond to this verse? What thoughts come to mind?

Read together Psalm 34:8.

If you were introduced to Jesus as a child, what was your experience of him then versus now?

What does it look like to place a radical trust in God?

When have you placed this type of trust in God?

Read together Matthew 5:14-16 and Psalm 8:2.

How inhibited or uninhibited do you feel when worshipping God?

When, if ever, have you been inspired by the uninhibited worship of a child or another adult?

How fully do you let your light shine for those around you? Describe what this looks like.

Read together Matthew 13:44-46 and Jeremiah 29:13.

How adventurous does your faith walk feel today?

How passionate are you in your pursuit of God?

What could it look like, if needed, to reawaken or to awaken for the first time a more adventurous and passionate faith walk?

Read together Matthew 25:31 and 34-40.

When have you been inspired by the compassion of those around you?

How easy or difficult is it for you to see those around you as Jesus sees them?

What does it look like, or could it look like for you to live with this type of compassion?

If you have gotten too busy to observe or spend time with children, what might this message be speaking to you?

Conclude by praying for one another in taking practical next steps in applying this weekend's message and group discussion, after which pray for group needs and concerns.
