Living a Life of Significance

(Acts 20)

Group Interaction & Application

Read aloud Acts 20.

What words, phrases, concepts, or images from these verses stand out to you as you just read them, or create curiosity for you in some way?

What aspects of Pastor Alan's message gave you fresh insight into this passage, or helped you the most in understanding these verses and what we experience here?

Who have you known personally who inspired you by the legacy they left behind (or who is currently inspiring you with the legacy they are still creating)?

What legacy do you long to leave? And if you have not spent much time thinking about this, take a moment with your group to reflect on this and share your thoughts.

Within this passage, Pastor Alan highlights four focuses of Paul's life that contributed to Paul living a life of impact.

First, Paul focused on relationships. (vs. 17-19)

How intentional are you in building relationships?

To whom do you find yourself in regular proximity? How connected are you to these people?

Who do you know who you sense needs someone to reach out to them?

Second, Paul focused on advancing the gospel. (vs. 20-27)

What purpose most drives you when you wake up each morning?

Whatever the answer you just gave, how fulfilling is this purpose?

If you feel a lack of purpose, what could a more meaningful life look like for you?

Third, Paul focused on the church. (vs. 28-32)

In what ways, if any, does Paul's strategy of nurturing the spread of the gospel through local churches inspire or challenge you?

In what ways are you currently participating in Paul's vision for the church?

If you are feeling inspired to become more involved in the local church, what could that look like?

Fourth, Paul focused on generosity. (vs. 34-35)

Who has inspired you through their generosity?

When have you experienced the feeling of being more blessed to give than to receive? (vs. 35)

If you feel called to do so, what steps could you take to live a more generous life?

Conclude by praying for one another in taking practical next steps in applying this weekend's message and group discussion, after which pray for group needs and concerns.
