## Prepare for Something Small

(Acts 18:1-23)

## Group Interaction & Application

Read aloud Acts 18:1-23.

What words, phrases, concepts, or images from these verses stand out to you as you just read them, or create curiosity for you in some way?

What aspects of Pastor KJ's message gave you fresh insight into this passage, or helped you the most in understanding these verses and what we experience here?

Read together Matthew 13:31-32.

Who have you known personally who has/had the gift of planting mustard seeds in the world around them? Share what this looked like?

When have you seen God's work take off like a mustard seed in your own life – growing into something you did not anticipate? And do not dismiss this question too quickly thinking you have not had this kind of impact.

Within Acts Chapter 18, we see amazing these taking root out of the ordinary spaces of Paul's life, in his work (18:3), in sacred places (18:4), in his places of fear (18:9), in his private walk (18:18) and in his everyday relationships (18:19-21).

How do you currently bring Jesus into your place of employment (or if not employed, the places you visit often)?

If you feel called to do so, how could you be more intentional in bringing Jesus to the people in these places?

How do you currently share your gifts within the sacred settings you attend (church, small groups, etc.)?

If you desire to contribute more to these settings, what could it look like?

If you find yourself currently questioning why you are where you are in your current life, how are you navigating this season?

If you have navigated a season like this in the past, how did it go and in what ways, if any, did you bring Jesus into this situation?

Like Paul taking the Nazarite vow (vs. 18), when, if ever, have you given yourself more deeply over to God? What did this look like and what resulted?

If you have not experienced this type of commitment and it appeals to you, what could it look to live in a season of deeper devotion or deeper awareness of God?

Where have you experienced relationships grow in unexpected places?

When have you seen Jesus work in the life of someone (or in yourself) through these unexpected relationships?

What encouragement, if any, do you take from this message?

Conclude by praying for one another in taking practical next steps in applying this weekend's message and group discussion, after which pray for group needs and concerns.
