## Our Part in God's Purposes

(Acts 25-26)

## Group Interaction & Application

Read aloud Acts 25-26.

What words, phrases, concepts, or images from these verses stand out to you as you just read them, or create curiosity for you in some way?

What aspects of Pastor Alan's message gave you fresh insight into this passage, or helped you the most in understanding these verses and what we experience here?

If someone were to ask you what your purpose is, how would you respond?

If you have clarity on your purpose, what is your level of conviction to live this purpose out?

Within this portion of Scripture, Pastor Alan highlights two ways to help us discover, rediscover, or refocus our purpose.

First, we need to remember the promises God has made to us. (Acts 9:15, 23:11)

What promises have you received from God – through His Word, through other believers, through the Holy Spirit?

How have these promises played out over your life?

When have you received validation/confirmation that you are on the correct path – that these promises have been fulfilled?

When have you been frustrated by what you perceive as a lack of validation/confirmation?

If you feel a current calling, but at the same time feel stuck, share a bit about the tension you are wrestling with.

Or if you feel a lack of calling, what could it look like to explore this in the coming days?

Second, we can Reconnect with the story of Jesus' work in our lives. (Acts 26:9-15)

What did your life look like before entering an intimate relationship with Jesus?

What did your life orbit around before Jesus?

What does your life look like after entering an intimate relationship with Jesus?

How fully are you living a life that orbits around Jesus?

If you long to grow in this reality, what steps are needed?

What might be getting in the way?

As you reflect on this portion of Scripture, how are you viewing your commitment to your own purpose at the start of 2026?

If you long to live a greater life of purpose in 2026, what initial steps can you take?

Conclude by praying for one another in taking practical next steps in applying this weekend's message and group discussion, after which pray for group needs and concerns.
