### Why the End Matters

(Acts 28:17-31)

### Group Interaction & Application

Read aloud Acts 28:17-31.

What words, phrases, concepts, or images from these verses stand out to you as you just read them, or create curiosity for you in some way?

What aspects of Pastor Stetson's message gave you fresh insight into this passage, or helped you the most in understanding these verses and what we experience here?

What has been one of the favorite endings (i.e. life season, movie, book, etc.) you have encountered in life?

As we conclude the book of Acts, Pastor Stetson challenges us to see this not as an ending, but instead as a launching point – a beginning!

How did you first encounter the gospel?

What did it look like for you once you started to fully embrace this new reality?

If you question whether you have fully embraced the promise of the gospel, share what you are feeling with your group?

How are you currently playing a part in advancing the hope of God's Kingdom?

How, if at all, has how you exhibit/live the gospel evolved throughout your faith walk?

If you have a fun experience of helping introduce the gospel to someone, share a bit about how this played out and what it meant to the person who received this good news.

Spend a moment reading the following scriptures together as a group:

Acts 1:8, John 14:12, John 15:16, John 20:21

How do you feel as you read these verses?

How easy or difficult is it for you to believe that the same Spirit who empowered Paul is residing in you and longing to work in similar ways?

Whether this is easy or difficult for you, why might either be the case?

What did you feel as you watched the music clip Pastor Stetson shared?

As we wrap up the book of Acts, what is stirring within you?

Conclude by praying for one another in taking practical next steps in applying this weekend's message and group discussion, after which pray for group needs and concerns.
