## Group Interaction & Application

Read aloud the following portions of scripture which give us a glimpse into two different periods of Peter's life: Luke 22:54-60 and 1 Peter 1:3.

What words, phrases, concepts, or images from these verses stand out to you as you just read them, or create curiosity for you in some way?

What aspects of Pastor Alan's message gave you fresh insight into this passage, or helped you the most in understanding these verses and what we experience here?

Peter is a powerful example of what a resurrected life can look like.

Before the resurrection, Pastor Alan sees Peter placing his value and strength in "self."

Where have you potentially placed your strength (either in the past or in the present) other than Jesus and how has this gone?

Where are you most vulnerable to feelings of, "I'm not enough."?

If you have grown in placing your value in Jesus, how has this come about?

What does it look like for you to live more fully in this reality?

What practical steps do you take to nurture this?

If you feel stuck – unable to access the life Jesus longs for you to live, what could be getting in the way?

What steps could you take to move forward in experiencing a resurrected life?

Beyond Peter, who do you know personally who is a powerful example of living a resurrected life?

What have you observed in this person that inspires you?

Who in your life is helping you remember your true identity?

In what ways are you helping those around you remember their true identity?

Whose life could you speak into this week - helping them remember or maybe discover for the first time their true identity?

Conclude by praying for one another in taking practical next steps in applying this weekend's message and group discussion, after which pray for group needs and concerns.
