Everyone Gets to Play

(I Peter 4:10-11)

Group Interaction & Application

Read aloud together I Peter 4:10-11.

What words, phrases, concepts, or images from these verses stand out to you as you just read them, or create curiosity for you in some way?

What aspects of Pastor Alan's message gave you fresh insight into this passage, or helped you the most in understanding these verses and what we experience here?

When have you been a part of a community (a family, a team, a local church, etc.) that was strengthened through hardship? How did you contribute?

Within this portion of scripture, Pastor Alan highlights three ways we can help build up the body of Christ.

First, we can discover our gift(s). (vs. 10)

If you have waded into the world of spiritual gifts, what have you discovered about yourself?

If you have clarity on your gift(s), what is it?

If you have wrestled with discovering your gift(s), share a bit about this struggle.

Pastor Alan highlighted two key ways to help us discover our gifts:

First, listen to your heart - pay attention to your passions/interests.

Second, just start exploring – try something and see what resonates.

If you are in the process of uncovering your gift(s), what could it look like for you to “listen to your heart” and/or “try something.”

Second, we can own our responsibility to use our gift(s). (vs. 10)

Why is it so important to utilize our gift(s)?

In what ways are you currently using your gift(s)?

In what ways could you more fully engage your gift(s)?

How is the use of your gift(s) strengthening the body of Christ?

Third, we can enjoy the blessing of using our gift(s). (Matthew 25:23)

In what ways have you experienced joy through using your spiritual gift(s)?

How, if at all, does using your gift(s) make you feel more connected to God?

How has God used you to impact His Kingdom by using your gift(s)?

If you have found ways to share your gift in unexpected ways, share how so.

After hearing this sermon, what new ways are you potentially inspired to dive into learning more about your gift(s) and or using your gift(s)?
