Who Are You Becoming?

(I Samuel 1:21-2:10)

Group Interaction & Application

Read aloud together I Samuel 1:21-2:10.

What words, phrases, concepts, or images from these verses stand out to you as you just read them, or create curiosity for you in some way?

What aspects of Pastor KJ's message gave you fresh insight into this passage, or helped you the most in understanding these verses and what we experience here?

Just as Hannah's heart was evolving within these passages, KJ presents the case that "every heart is becoming something."

As you have taken time to reflect on your own heart (and if you have not taken the time to do this yet, take some time to do it now), discuss with the group the following:

Where has your heart been recently?

Where is your heart today?

"If your heart could speak, what would it say?"

How is your heart evolving or what do you see your heart becoming?

What is currently shaping you?

Where is your heart currently leading you?

When you ponder God, how aligned is your heart with His?

Where you feel aligned, what is feeding this connection?

Where you feel misalignment, what could be causing this disconnect?

Hannah was on the cusp of something wonderful when she hit bottom – when she felt most “barren.”

When has a moment like this brought you ultimately closer to God?

If you feel barren right now, share with the group what you are experiencing.

We witness in Hannah a woman who hit bottom, who cried out to God in anguish, who received blessing from God and who out of a response of worship ultimately gave away the very thing she longed for.

As you observe/ponder Hannah’s experience, how do you suppose it is possible to get to a place where you can give away the very thing you longed for?

If you have experienced something like this firsthand, share a bit about this experience and how it has shaped your heart as you know it today?

Last week, we focused more on Hannah’s anguish. This week we focus more on Hannah’s worship.

When, if ever, have you worshipped God in a similar way?

What could you be or are you praising God for today?

Conclude by praying for one another in taking practical next steps in applying this weekend’s message and group discussion, after which pray for group needs and concerns.
