(I Samuel 10:9-27)

Group Interaction & Application

Read aloud together I Samuel 10:9-27.

What words, phrases, concepts, or images from these verses stand out to you as you just read them, or create curiosity for you in some way?

What aspects of Pastor Alan's message gave you fresh insight into this passage, or helped you the most in understanding these verses and what we experience here?

If you have ever wrestled with significant levels of insecurity, share a bit about this struggle.

When has fear stopped you from moving forward?

What was the resulting outcome of allowing the voice of fear to stop you?

What was at the root of this fear?

What voices or life situations contributed to this fear?

When have you moved forward in the face of fear?

What enabled you to move forward?

What was the outcome of making the choice to move forward?

If God's voice is the antidote to fear, how well are you hearing His voice?

If you have found ways to better tap into God's affirming voice, share what habits or practices have assisted you in this journey.

If you have ever felt a condemning voice from God, share a bit about this experience.

If this does not match God's character, where do you think this voice came from?

How do you tell the difference between fear and discernment?

How are these voices different?

Pastor Alan challenged us to begin or end our day this week by reading and reflecting on Romans 8:15-16.

If you have done this, how has it gone?

If you have not done this yet, take a moment to read and reflect on this portion of scripture together right now.

Conclude by praying for one another in taking practical next steps in applying this weekend's message and group discussion, after which pray for group needs and concerns.
