Joining What God is Doing

(I Samuel 9-10)

Group Interaction & Application

Read aloud together I Samuel 9-10.

What words, phrases, concepts, or images from these verses stand out to you as you just read them, or create curiosity for you in some way?

What aspects of Pastor Nate's message gave you fresh insight into this passage, or helped you the most in understanding these verses and what we experience here?

How engaged with God's story do you currently feel?

Pastor Nate offers three insights from this passage that can help us join God in what He's doing.

First insight, Pay attention to what is in front of us.

When has God presented an unexpected opportunity for you as you were going about your normal rhythms of life?

When you noticed this opportunity, how did you respond?

When have you felt like God presented an opportunity, but you chose to ignore it?

What was the outcome of this decision?

How can we live a life that is more attentive to these opportunities?

Second insight, Do not let your past decide what is possible.

When have you been tempted to pass on an opportunity God placed before you because you do not believe you have the experience for the call?

If you worked through this hesitation and moved forward anyway, what was the outcome?

If this reservation caused you to pass on this opportunity, what was the outcome?

It could seem wise to not take on a “calling” we feel ill equipped to handle.

How do you wrestle with this reality?

If shame from your past is holding you back from engaging more fully with God, what steps can you take to move past this shame?

Third insight, Trust God’s presence more than our ability.

When have you successfully navigated a challenge in a way that seemed outside of your ability?

When, if ever, have you had a moment where the only logical explanation you could provide for how you responded in that moment was God’s presence?

If you have found ways to be more attentive to God in your daily walk, what does this look like for you?

If you struggle to feel God’s presence, what steps might you take to nurture this reality?

As Pastor Nate challenged us, if you are feeling called to a specific action in your current season of life, share what this call is with your group.

Conclude by praying for one another in taking practical next steps in applying this weekend’s message and group discussion, after which pray for group needs and concerns.
